She falls in love with her master, the Duke whilst carrying his declarations of love to the Countess Olivia, who adamantly refuses to hear them. The confusion is increased by Olivia falling in love with this attractive new messenger from the Duke. With much comedy from ‘Sir Toby and the lighter people’ the Play comes to a happy conclusion.
